Background

An Army veteran, business owner and Florida native, Mills emphasized energy independence and national defense in his first bid for Congress

Born in Winter Haven, Florida, Mills was adopted and raised by his grandparents; joined the US Army and served with the 82nd Airborne Division

Served seven years in Iraq, almost three years in Afghanistan, as well as Kosovo; earned associate's degree from Florida State College at Jacksonville, bachelor's from American Military University (AMU), and was a master's degree candidate at AMU from 2013 until 2020

In 2014, Mills co-founded PACEM Solutions International, LLC, which manufactures riot-control munitions for law enforcement

In 2020, he received the attention of the House Oversight and Reform Committee for PACEM's sale of tear gas to US law enforcement in 2020 amid Black Lives Matter protests

From December 2020 through February 2021, Mills served as an advisor to President Trump on the Board of Advisors of the Defense Business Board at the Department of Defense
