Background

Military veteran whose time at the district attorney's office inspired him to pursue elected office; launched a congressional bid to represent North Carolina's 14th District largely molded by years of his prosecutorial and legislative experience

Obtained a BA and a MA in Philosophy at Emory University: earned a JD at the University of North Carolina School of Law after serving in the US Army

Enlisted in the US Army Reserve during his junior year at Emory following the September 11th attacks; trained at Ft. Bragg and served in Afghanistan

Continues to serve as a major for the North Carolina Army National Guard; as a member of the Judge Advocate General's Corps, Jackson serves as trial counsel for the 130th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade where he gives legal advice on operational law, fiscal law, administrative law, and military justice

Worked as an assistant district attorney in Gaston County, NC, for three years; tried over 200 bench and 18 jury trials, managed a caseload of over 150 felony cases, and trained and supervised new assistant district attorneys

Elected state senator for the 37th district in 2014; sat on the Appropriations on Justice and Public Safety Committee, Judiciary Committee, State and Local Government Committee, Transportation Committee, and Agriculture, Energy, and Environment Committee
